Bag Drive Initial Report - to date they has been 925 permits issued for which the Twp. received \$23,125. . The cost of the bags purchased was \$ 29,165 and it is estimated that the Twp will issue rebates for sewer billings and ambulance rebates in excess of \$110,000. The cost of refuse and recycling increased from \$ 18,558 to 24,541 per month. It should be noted that despite advertising two times for bids only ONE bid was received.

Ed Suchecki - wanted to inquire as to the use of the new packer. He has much debris in his yard to be picked up. Supervisors Slezak explained the restrictions and would go and look at the problem.

Donna Renavro - IACC debris on side of her house. Supervisor Rinaldi requested that she fill out a formal complaint and it would be acted upon.

Ron Kielb - same as before Move the line..... Read to the general public the recent Notice of Violation and asked what was being done to address issues. He was assured that it was being discussed and that there was a meeting set up with DEP regarding the Notice.

Megan Galonis - has issues with the Engineering Firm used by the Authority and the Twp. Wanted to know where the money was coming from to fix the issues left by the Sewer Authority.

Janice Lane - issues with MS-4 billing. Wants the Twp. to join with others to fight against the MS-4 project. She also has issues with the use of PennEastern and Mike Amato. She was to forward to the Twp. the law firm which handled MS-4 problem in another area.

Ed Galonis - had thoughts about the sewer rebate of the WVSA quarterly billing by the Twp.
