**Bryan Giambra** - what action is being taken on Chapel Road Pipe. Receiving conflicting information and wants to know from the Supervisors what is going to be done before the road is paved . He stated that pipes were ripped out during the sewer project and never replaced. Steve discussed easements which are trying to be secured and would contact Mr. Giambra before any work is done.

**Joe Lakowski** - complained about inaction by Steve about salt on his road. Dave stated that he did in fact salt the road when called by Steve. Joe apologized

**Ron Kielb** - same . Informed by Supervisors of late fees which should be imposed against the contractor for delays. Stated that since the state performed repairs on the culvert on Suscon road the water flow to his property has gotten worse, not better as promised. Stated that at the Sewer meeting a resident was told by their Solicitor that they will be forced to hook up and if they object to the hookup legal action will be taken to insure that a hookup is made. Also questioned as to whether or not the Supervisors were aware of a lawsuit against the contractor by the Sewer Authority. Supervisors knew nothing about any lawsuits filed by the Sewer Authority
