**BRYAN GIAMBRA** - Wanted update on status of ditch project on Chapel Road. According to the Supervisors there was a preliminary cost prepared by Mike Amato along with suggested drawings of the scope if the work. Several problems exists and must be addressed before considering this project. According to Mr. Giambra the pipe can be restored regardless of the status of the Sewer Project. Supervisors feel that it cannot be done until other work is done in the area which is being effected because of the Sewer Project. Supervisors agree that there was a pipe in the suggested area before and for some reason it was removed and never replaced. Mr. Giambra also stated that recently there have been tractor trailers on Chapel road due to faulty GPS instructions and that there are several "craters" in the road. Supervisors agreed to meet with Mike Amato and Mr. Giambra and will set up a meeting to discuss.

**RON KIELB** - read letter from DEP which opines that the Twp. is responsible for the completion of the project. Mr. Bonita acknowledged that the Supervisors received this letter from DEP. Mr. Kielb questioned as to the status of late fees which he feels should be imposed upon the contractor. No comment from the Supervisors. Comment on:

1. Sewer Line Vs the location of his well. Drawing by PennEastern were grossly in error
2. Sewer Line on chosen side of the road Vs where it was placed
3. Cost of extra pipe, concrete, excavation caused by line on wrong side of road
4. Concrete encasement necessary because of placing the line on the wrong side of the road
5. Water being diverted from PDOT culvert because of line on wrong side of the road
6. 2016 lawsuit filed against the PTSAuthority
7. Promised additional legal action

**JANICE LANE** - continued her assault on the MS-4 program being administered by the WVSA. Continues to maintain that it is something the Twp. should handle independently and questioned the use of the money to be charged to residents by WVSA. Mr. Bonita pointed out several errors in her statement and promised to try to set up a "town meeting" and have representatives of WVSA MS-4 Division present to answer questions.
