Rose Williams - discussed the recent robbery at her home. Stated that she was not satisfied with the response and comments of the investigating officer. Only on the midnight shift. Cannot do fingerprinting. Stated that the Twp. is growing but the police department is not. She has been told that the department does not have enough time to answer all the calls.

Ron Kielb - same as before Wanted to know what is being done about the list of complaints. Twp. Solicitor was to handle complaints. Solicitor Sanguedolce stated he has been in contact with the solicitor for the Authority. Questioned the applicability of late fees. Was told to contact his own lawyer for legal advise. Asked for a copy of Ordinance 5-01 of 2018. Mr. Bonita was to forward a copy to him.

Janice Lane - briefly spoke at the podium about the problems relating to the sewer project. She said her opinion is that the blame rests on the Sewer Authority Board, Solicitor and the Engineer.

Gordon Maxwell - has received no contact from anyone regarding his complaints and issues relating to the sewer project. Questioned the logic of the Authority in paying the contractor who refuses to come back to complete the job. He was told at one meeting that the contractor would not be paid and learned that the

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contractor was paid at the next meeting. Has well water damage, low water pressure and no connection to the system. Requests that the Supervisors insist that the "bond" against the contractor be enforced. Steve will check out.
