Supervisors Comments

Supervisor Sabacucchi reminded those in attendance of the Crime Watch meeting to be held on Wed., June 21, 2017/

Public Comment Speakers are reminded of the 10 minute time allotment

Lois Vilikoski - Tractor Trailer traffic on Church Drive - Supervisor Rinaldi said the solution to the problem would be to close the road so that there would be no inlet on church. He must talk to Pagnotti Enterprises to discuss. He assured taxpayers that the Twp. will take all precautions to insure safety of the residents.

Ron Kielb - same as previously. Had 4 statements to be considered:

1. Mike Amato did not properly locate wells on the 537 Plan
2. Concrete encasements caused change orders - how much
3. Scope changes between grant application and construction - wants to see amendments to grant application
4. Wants copies of feasibility studies conducted. He maintains none exist.

Questioned again if penalties would be imposed for late date construction schedule.

Janice Lane - continued about Mike Amato's letter.. Questioned the Supervisors about Mr. Amato's performance in other Twp. matters.

At this point Mr. Bonita stated that (a) he was informed that a new letter has been written by Mr. Amato on behalf of PennEastern but he has not seen the letter; and (2) the Twp. has secured the services of Geo-Science Engineering Co. to perform an independent geo-technical study of the area which Mr. Kielb has been complaining about.

Megan Galonis - two issues: (1) Regionalization - she feels that the Twp. should not enter into regionalization if only three officers will be on duty. She maintains that it is a mistake on the part of the Supervisors to consider regionalization. She was invited to attend the next and future regionalization

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meetings; and (2) the status of the Suscon fire station since the road will not be open. She heard that the 24/7 coverage would be discontinued and she felt that the 24/7 coverage should be maintained.

Curt Muffley - commended the Police Dept. for their fine service and stated he would like to see more citations on 502. Complained about the recent 911 decision to modify/change addresses in the Brookside Lane area.

James Sulima - commended the fire dept for a prompt response to a car fire in his area. Is concerned also about regionalization and he was also invited to attend the next and future meetings. Asked if the Twp. had a gypsy moth program. He contacted the state and county and was referred to the Twp.. He stated that it is too late to do anything this year but his opinion is that spraying in the Fall of 2017 would affect 2018 and later years. He estimates that a 50Acre area would have to be sprayed in order for it to be effective. Supervisor Sciabacucchi questioned the liability for spraying and asked what would be the effect if certain homeowners in the area sprayed objected. He did not receive an answer to his question.

Emitt Maninelli - engineer representing Arbys. Concerned about a dirt road adjacent to Arbys. Noone claimed ownership. Supervisor Rinaldi and T. Best would meet with Mr. Maninelli at a date to be scheduled.

RECYCLING BUILDING: Advertisement for Bids appeared in the Citizens Voice on May 12 and May 19, 2017 for renovations to heating system and garage doors at the Recycling Center which houses our maintenance equipment. Bids are due on June 30, 2017

The Board of Supervisors of Pittston Township must considering passing an Ordinance approving an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement with the Wyoming Valley Sanitary Authority for the creation and implementation of a stormwater management program. The notice of intent to consider passage was advertised in the Citizens Voice on June 8 and June 9, 2017. A copy of the ordinance was available for public inspection at the Twp. municipal building beginning on June 8th between the hours of 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

A copy of the ordinance was distributed to the Supervisors for their review and comments.

A discussion took place as to whether or not to join the WVSA or to attempt the process on our own. Several residents objected to the monthly fee to be charged to each resident. Supervisor Sciabacucchi explained the complexity of the project and the long range plans and how it will eventually benefit the environment.
