Ron Keilb - continued his attack on the Sewer Board and on the sewer project, specifically the 650' section of pipe. Presented a bill for damages to Steve Rinaldi which Supervisor Rinaldi dismissed.

Ed Galonis - questioned the rumors about the sale of Fairgrounds. He was advised that the Fairground property is the property of the PTN TWP Volunteer Fire Dept. and any concerns he has should be addressed to them.

Megan Galonis - questioned the closing of Suscon Road for lateral work. She had been in touch with PDOT and received different information about road closure than was told to her by the Contractor and the Authority. She was concerned about emergency response when the road is closed and felt that the residents were placed in harms way.
