The Board of Supervisors of Pittston Township conducted a public hearing at the Township Municipal Building located at 421 Broad Street, Pittston, PA to consider and accept public comment regarding an application to transfer a restaurant liquor license (number R-925) (LID No. 58580) from Ashley Ventures, Inc., Ashley Borough, to Beer Kings Enterprises, Inc. to operate the license out of premises located at 170 Laurel Plaza, Unit 5, Pittston Township, Luzerne County, PA

Due to a lack of a quorum, The Board of Supervisors of Pittston Township postponed a public hearing scheduled for January 15, 2016 at 11:00 AM at the Township Municipal Building located at 421 Broad Street, Pittston, PA to consider and accept public comment regarding an application to transfer a restaurant liquor license (number R-925) (LID No. 58580) from Ashley Ventures, Inc., Ashley Borough, to Beer Kings Enterprises, Inc. to operate the license out of premises located at 170 Laurel Plaza, Unit 4, Pittston Township, Luzerne County, PA and rescheduled the public hearing to January 20, 2016 at 11:00 AM at the Township Municipal Building located at 421 Broad Street, Pittston, PA.

Notice of the hearing on the proposed Ordinance was duly advertised. Notice of the postponement and rescheduling was also posted at the municipal building up to the time of this meeting.

The meeting was transcribed and a copy of the transcript of the meeting is available to all interested parties.

When the meeting was called to order at 11:00 A.M, no representatives of the public were present.

Atty. Stahl stated that Mr. Scarantino has held liquor license applications in the past and had no violations or convictions. He will operate a kraft beer store and a grab & go operation for take-outs. He will have 3-4 employees and the location of the store will be in a commercial district.

Atty Finnerty reviewed the proposed ordinance and found all to be satisfactory. Steve Rinaldi questioned the location and we were advised that they are currently under negotiation with the landlord regarding lease. We were advised that the transfer of the license is contingent on securing a
