**Audit Presentation** - Michael Fiorielli, CPA. Mr. Fiorielli presented in summary form the revenue and expenditures of the Township for 2015 and fund balance. He stated that his opinion on the condition of the books and records is unqualified, which is the highest form of assurance that an independent CPA can render. He stated that the books and records were well kept and that he received total cooperation from the staff. He thanked the Twp. for the opportunity to be of service.

Mr. Bonita will publish a condensed financial statement in the paper and submit the DCED annual report.

**David Kaminski** - questioned as to why the web page was not up to date. Mr. Bonita said that he had just updated the web page prior to the meeting and will monitor it in the future to insure that it was up to date. Mr. Kaminski asked why salaries were not published. Mr. Bonita advised him that a right to know request should be filled out requesting this information and it would be made available. Supervisor Sciabacucchi commented on the procedure for setting salaries for Supervisors. The elected auditors must approve the salaries each year.

**William Rinaldi** - complained about the garbage allowed to accumulate on a property on Oak St. He stated that for nine months he has been complaining to the Supervisors and nothing is being done. Mr. Best advised that a bench warrant was issued by the District Magistrate against the owner of the property since the owner of the property is responsible. Supervisor Rinaldi questioned if another family member could be held responsible if the owner cannot be located. Mr. Rinaldi stated that there were 43 bags of garbage, some bags filled with construction material. Terry Best was asked by the Supervisors to check out and report back to them. It was noted that there is a four bag limit per week.

**Lori Adams** - took issue with the recent comments made on social media by Supervisor Attardo's daughter as well as to comments allegedly made by Supervisor Sciabacucchi in a local public establishment. Asked for a copy of the Vacancy Board minutes and was advised by Mr. Bonita to submit a right to know request. She also stated that the Mr. Musto did not do due diligences before voting.
