Public Comment Speakers are reminded of the 10 minute time allotment Joseph McNamara - spoke about the increase in water flowing on his road as a result of the sewer project. Supervisor Sciabacucchi spoke about the remedies the Twp. has done in the past several weeks, including cleaning the storm drain located on Nocito property and the lines with the use of a vac truck. He stated that Mike Amato viewed the flow pattern and was happy with the way the water was flowing after the maintenance of the storm drain. Mr. Bonita spoke to Mr. McNamara and stated that there is a pending resolution which will be presented later for approval and according to our solicitor there should be a formal agreement with Mr./Mrs. McNamara before any work is done on his land. He seemed to indicate that the legal document was not necessary. He was given a copy of the resolution and the easement for his review and signature and was advised that no work would be done until it is returned. He was advised that Ms. Taroli will be available after 12:00 each day to notarize the document.  Anthony Angelella, Jr. stated that 432 calls y/t/d have been answered by the fire dept so far this year. The most ever recorded by the fire dept was 480 per year. The call volume has increased substantially. In the audience were members of the ambulance who confirmed that the call volume has increased in the Township.
