The Board of Supervisors of Pittston Township conducted a public hearing on November 3, 2016 at 10:00 AM at the Township Municipal Building located at 421 Broad Street, Pittston, PA to consider, and accept public comment regarding the application of Pittston Beer & Deli, Inc. to transfer a liquor license that was formerly held and operated by a licensee in Duryea to a convenience store located at 325 Laurel St., Pittston Township, PA.

As Atty Finnerty pointed out, the notice of the hearing was advertised October 17 and October 24, 2016 in the Citizens Voice. Also, Atty Finnerty pointed out that there was no public at the meeting.

The meeting was transcribed and a copy of the transcript of the meeting will be made available to all interested parties.

Atty O'Brien outlined the type of license and the sales which would take place. The proper corporate name of the applicant is Pittston Convenience, Inc. d/b/a Food X Press. There will be a small seating area as required by the LCB but management intends to limit the consumption on premises to one can of beer. No liquor or wine will be served. Hours of operation for the license will be from 7:00 AM to 2:00 AM.

Mr. Bonita checked the Mercantile Tax Filing and advised that there was no record of mercantile taxes paid by Pittston Convenience, Inc. Mr. Patel stated he was not aware of the requirement and would have the delinquency settled. His local attorney, Pat Argood, will be contacted by Mr. Bonita and get him the necessary forms.

It was mutually decided to hold off action on this application until Mr. Bonita gets the filings from Atty Argood. This will be placed on the agenda for the November 15, 2016 special hearing which has been already been scheduled.
