RESOLUTION NO 4-02 of 2023

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PITTSTON, LUZERNE COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, APPOINTING ALTERNATE MEMBERS TO
THE PITTSTON TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, Pittston Township has previously created a Planning Commission consisting of five (5) members and the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code Article II at Section 203(a) states that all members shall be appointed by the appointing authority for a term of four (4) years; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code Article II at Section 203(e) states that the governing body may appoint by resolution at least one (1) but not more than three (3) residents of the municipality to serve as alternate members of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of the Township of Pittston find it is in the best interest of the Township to appoint alternate members to the Planning Commission and have identified residents who are qualified to serve as alternate members of the Planning Commission.

NOW THEREFORE, be it and it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of Pittston Township, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

THAT, KIM WARUNEK and ROBERT FAHEY are appointed as alternate members of the Planning Commission with terms that expires on December 31, 2025.

THAT, any alternate may participate in any proceeding or discussion of the Planning Commission but shall not be entitled to vote as a member of the commission nor be reimbursed pursuant to section 202 unless designated as a voting alternate member pursuant to section 207(b).

THAT, any alternate member appointed by the Chairman as an alternate voting member shall continue to serve as a voting member in all proceedings involving the matter or case for which the alternate was initially appointed until the commission has made a final decision on the matter or case. Designation of an alternate shall be made on a case-by-case basis in rotation according to declining seniority among all alternates.

THAT, the provisions of this Resolution are severable and if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or otherwise illegal or unenforceable, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

THAT, all resolutions, ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.

THAT, this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage.


