RESOLUTION NO. 4-03 of 2025

**A Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of Pittston Township Pursuant to Section 2325
of the Second-Class Township Code Establishing the Form of Notice to be Given to an Abutting Property
Owner of the Intent of the Township to Remove a Tree with a Trunk Diameter in Excess of Six Inches from
the Township Right-Of-Way Which Constitute a Dangerous Condition and Delegating Authority to the
Roadmaster to Make Findings of Hazardous or Dangerous Conditions**

WHEREAS, Section 2325 of the Second-Class Township Code regulates the removal of trees and shrubs within the Township right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, Section 2325 of the Second-Class Township Code requires the Township to establish a form of notice to abutting property owners prior to the removal of a tree in the Township right-of-way which has a diameter in excess of six (6) inches; and

WHEREAS, Section 2302 of the Second-Class Township Code authorizes the Roadmaster to do or direct to be done all work necessary to carry out the responsibilities imposed by the Board of Supervisors with respect to maintenance, repair and construction of Township Roads.

NOW THEREFORE, be it and it is hereby **RESOLVED** as follows:


THAT, the Township Roadmaster is hereby delegated to make findings that the following constitute or may in the future constitute a hazardous or dangerous condition to the use or maintenance of a Township Road or which impair the use or maintenance of a Township Road warranting removal of same:

1. Trees in the Township right-of-way;
2. Shrubs in the Township right-of-way; and
3. Branches of trees which overhang the right-of-way where the trunks are outside the right-of-way.

THAT, Notice shall be given to abutting property owners as required by Section 2325 via Certified Mail.






