RESOLUTION #6-02 of 2025**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PITTSTON  
TOWNSHIP AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY STORMWATER REMEDIATION**

**WHEREAS**, on June 10, 2025, the Township experienced a rainfall event which caused roadways, residential properties and swales to flood.

**WHEREAS**, the flooding caused roadways to flood and erode. Swales and pipes are unable to sufficiently discharge stormwater due to debris clogging the swales and pipes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Second Class Township Code and the Procurement Code permits a municipality to enter into contracts without adhering to the advertising and public bidding requirements of the Code, in order to mitigate a real or potential emergency involving a clear and present danger to the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Township, subject to adoption of a resolution confirming such emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, a real emergency involving a clear and present danger to the health, safety and welfare of the Township residents exists due to stormwater flooding.

**WHEREAS**, immediate remediation of the swales and pipes was/is necessary to ensure the health, safety and welfare of the Township residents and motorists; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township obtained an emergency proposal from Latona Trucking & Excavating in the amount of \$2,800 per day on an emergency basis in order to remediate the stormwater issues.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of Pittston Township that in recognition of the emergency that exists the emergency proposal of Latona Trucking & Excavating is hereby affirmed and approved.

**BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THIS 16<sup>th</sup> day of JUNE 2025**, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pittston.
