RESOLUTION #10-02 of 2025**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PITTSTON
TOWNSHIP AUTHORIZING THE EMERGENCY STORMWATER
REMEDATION AT THE PITTSTON TWP. LITTLE LEAGUE FIELD**

WHEREAS, on September 24, 2025, a sinkhole emerged at 26 Bryden Street at the Pittston Township Little League complex creating a clear and present danger to the health, safety and welfare of members of the little league and residents of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Second-Class Township Code and the Pennsylvania Procurement Code permit a municipality to enter into contracts without adhering to the advertising and public bidding requirements of the Code, in order to mitigate a real or potential emergency involving a clear and present danger to the health, safety and welfare of the public, subject to adoption of a resolution confirming such emergency; and

WHEREAS, a real emergency involving a clear and present danger to the health, safety and welfare of coaches, ball players and residents exists due to the sinkhole; and

WHEREAS, immediate remediation was necessary to ensure the health, safety and welfare of the coaches, ball players and residents of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township obtained an emergency proposal from Arena Trucking and Excavating Inc. in the amount of \$78,934.50 on an emergency basis in order to remediate and repair the sinkhole and repair and replace the collapsed piping.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Pittston Township that in recognition of the emergency that existed at the Pittston Township Little League on or about September 24, 2025, the emergency proposal of Arena Trucking and Excavating Inc. to remediate the stormwater issue at the little league is hereby affirmed and approved.
