

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PITTSTON,
COUNTY OF LUZERNE, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA,
ADOPTING THE 2026 BUDGET AND FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 2026.**

WHEREAS, the Township of Pittston has prepared and intends to adopt a Budget in accordance with the Second-Class Township Code for the fiscal year of January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026; and,

WHEREAS, the Township of Pittston has given public notice by advertisement that the proposed 2026 Budget was available for inspection at the Township Building and via its website; and

WHEREAS, the proposed 2026 Budget has been available for public inspection for at least twenty (20) days; and

WHEREAS, the total appropriation under the proposed 2026 Budget does not exceed the revenues estimated as available for the 2026 fiscal year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby resolved and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pittston as follows:

Section 1: Tax Rate for Fiscal Year 2026.

That a tax is hereby levied on all real property within the Township subject to taxation for the fiscal year 2026, as follows:

- a. The tax rate for General Purposes is established at the tax rate of 0.95 mills constituting \$0.095 cents upon each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation of taxable property.
- b. The tax rate for EMS Protection Purposes is established at the tax rate of 0.95 mills constituting \$0.095 cents upon each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation of taxable property.
- c. That all other taxes adopted by ordinance, referendum and/or other permitted action of the Board of Supervisors of Pittston Township be collected in accordance with the law.

THAT, a copy of this Resolution shall be recorded in the Ordinance book within thirty (30) days of the passage hereof and shall remain on file in the Township of Pittston; and

THAT, all prior Ordinances and Resolutions of the Township of Pittston in irreconcilable conflict herewith are hereby repealed or superseded hereby; and

THAT, if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or otherwise illegal or unenforceable, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution; and

THAT, this Resolution shall take full force and effect on January 1, 2026.

BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED, by the Supervisors of the Township of Pittston, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania in lawful session duly assembled this 15th day of December 2025.
