

RESOLUTION NO. 2-01 of 2026
**DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY AND
DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT
COORDINATOR TO TAKE CERTAIN ACTIONS**

**TOWNSHIP OF PITTSTON TOWNSHIP
LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

WHEREAS, on or about Sunday, January 25, 2026, a severe winter storm is expected to cause injury, damage and suffering to persons and property within Pittston Township; and

WHEREAS, the storm is likely to endanger the health, safety and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing in Pittston Township and threatens to create problems greater in scope than Pittston Township may be able to contain; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of Pittston Township recognize that emergency measures are required to protect the health, safety and welfare of affected residents and property owners.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

THAT, the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors of Pittston Township pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Code, 35 Pa. C.S.A., Section 1701, et seq. do hereby declare the existence of a disaster emergency in Pittston Township; and

THAT, the Emergency Management Coordinator shall have all the authority delegated by the Emergency Management Code and is directed to coordinate the activities of the emergency response, to take all appropriate action needed to alleviate the effects of the disaster and to take any other emergency response action deemed necessary to respond to the disaster emergency to protect the health, safety and welfare of Township residents and their property; and

THAT, if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or otherwise illegal or unenforceable, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution; and


THAT, this Declaration shall take effect Sunday, January 25, 2026, at 12:00 a.m. and shall remain in effect until such time as the Declaration is lifted by the Emergency Management Coordinator, but in no event shall the Declaration continue for a period to exceed seven (7) days without the consent of the Board of Supervisors
