

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PITTSTON, LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA SETTING FORTH THE SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR CODE ENFORCEMENT APPEALS HEARINGS

WHEREAS, a municipality which has adopted an ordinance for the administration and enforcement of the Uniform Construction Code is required to establish or designate a board of appeals as provided by regulations promulgated by the department to hear appeals from decisions of the code administrator.

WHEREAS, the Township incurs certain costs related to code enforcement appeals for required newspaper advertising, stenography fees and other costs associated with conducting appeal hearings and it is necessary and prudent to set forth a fee schedule to ensure proper and complete cost recovery for the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the fee schedule for code enforcement appeals hearings shall be as follows:

Appeal to the Building and Property Maintenance Code Appeals Board: **\$550.00**

THAT, all prior Ordinances and Resolutions of the Township of Pittston in irreconcilable conflict herewith are hereby repealed or superseded hereby; and

THAT, if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or otherwise illegal or unenforceable, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution; and

THAT, this Resolution shall take full force and effect immediately upon passage.


