SUBJECT: 2021 FREE USED TIRE RECYCLING EVENTS

The Luzerne County Recycling Office and the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection will conduct two separate tire recycling collection events during October, 2021. Enclosed are the dates and site locations for each one. As always both collections will be held from 7:00 AM to 1:00 PM and are free of charge to all residents of Luzerne County only. This collection is **NOT** open to small garages/service stations, tire dealers or tire manufactures.

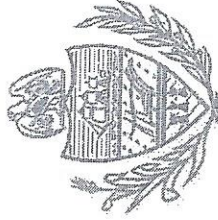
Tires eligible for collection include regular size Automobile, Motorcycle, Light Pick-up Truck, SUV, ATV and Farm Tractor Tires. All tires **must** be removed from rims, free of liquids and heavy mud and **cannot be cut. TIRES WILL BE REFUSED IF THEY ARE NOT CLEAN.** There will be a 16 tire limit per vehicle, for all residents. **ANY RESIDENT WHO WISHES TO PARTICIPATE MUST HAVE A REGISTRATION NUMBER.** All registered tires are counted and the total number is then sent to the tire vendor. This number, (no matter how high or low), will determine how many trucks will be needed for each collection. Therefore we ask that you please have an accurate count when you call to register. **TIRES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT A REGISTRATION NUMBER FROM RESIDENTS.** Both collections are a one day DROP-OFF only.

We require that all municipalities pre-register their trucks as there is a limit of 250 tires per township. Municipal trucks do **NOT** need a registration number. Please contact me at 1-800-821-7654 or with any questions or concerns you may have or to pre-register. **Please know the number of tires you intend to bring before you call to register.** Each municipality wishing to participate, please contact the office by Friday, September 24th, 12:00 noon.

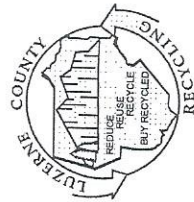
FREE TIRE collection
