

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Supervisors of Pittston Township shall convene public hearings to be held on Monday July 20, at 5:00 p.m. (prevailing time) at the Pittston Township Municipal Building, 421 Broad Street, Pittston Twp., PA 18640 in consideration of the following Ordinances:

- (1) An Ordinance of the Township of Pittston, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania Amending the Pittston Township Zoning Ordinance Adopted February 19, 2013, to Define and Add Special Requirements for Data Centers, Data Center Campuses and Data Center Accessory Uses.

The Ordinance amends the Pittston Township Zoning Ordinance for the purposes of providing definitions for data centers, data center campuses and data center accessory uses. The Ordinance further sets forth dimensional regulations, supplemental regulations and emergency response plan requirements for data centers and data center campuses.

- (2) An Ordinance of the Township of Pittston, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania Amending the Pittston Township Zoning Ordinance adopted February 19, 2013, to Define and Add Special Requirements for Medical Marijuana Facilities

The Ordinance amends the Pittston Township Zoning Ordinance for the purpose of providing a definition for medical marijuana facilities and provides definitions for terms supplemental to medical marijuana facilities. The Ordinance further sets forth use regulations for medical marijuana growers/processors, medical marijuana transport vehicle services and medical marijuana dispensaries.

At the time of the public hearing, the Supervisors will listen to comments by members of the public concerning the proposed amendments. If substantial amendments are not offered to the draft of the proposed Ordinances, the Supervisors intend to consider adoption at a regular meeting to follow immediately (6:00 p.m.) after the hearing.

To date, no data center proposal/application nor medical marijuana facility proposal/application has been submitted to the Pittston Township Board of Supervisors or its Zoning Officer.

Full texts of the Ordinances are available for inspection during regular business hours at the Office of the Township Secretary at the Pittston Township Municipal Building.
