PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **Pittston Township** Board of Supervisors, Pittston Township, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania, at a meeting to be held on Monday, July 20, 2026 at 6:00 p.m., prevailing time at the Pittston Township Municipal Building, 421 Broad Street, Pittston Township, Pennsylvania, will consider the introduction of the following Ordinance (of which is only a summary) by the Board of Supervisors. AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PITTSTON TOWNSHIP, LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSFER OF APPROXIMATELY 22.31 ACRES OF LAND FROM PITTSTON TOWNSHIP TO THE CITY OF PITTSTON AS AUTHORIZED BY ACT 41 OF JULY 7, 2022, P.L. 455, NO. 41), REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

The Ordinance authorizes the transfer of approximately 22.31 acres of land from Pittston Township to the City of Pittston in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Territory Transfer Agreement. The territory being considered for transfer is located in Stauffer Pointe Development and is generally bounded by Center Street, Valley View Terrace, and the existing boundary line of Pittston City and Pittston Township with the nearest streets to the borderline being Butler Street and Hunter Street. Any taxpayers or residents currently residing in Pittston Township will remain within the boundary line of Pittston Township and remain residents of Pittston Township.
